Description:

OCIE Fixed Content Managed Service from Donnell Systems is a world-class, online report and document viewing, archiving, data mining, and research solution built upon scalable, Network-centric, open computing technology. Donnell Systems functions as an Application Service Provider (ASP) for OCIE (pronounced “*Oh’-see*”), an acronym for “Online Computer Information Exchange.”

OCIE is a document management, report distribution, paper replacement, microfiche replacement, data mining and database conversion tool designed to warehouse audit trail data. OCIE, in conjunction with the Paperwork Reduction Act, accepts all PC, UNIX, and print-stream files from disparate sources. In addition, OCIE permits agencies to store and retrieve scanned image files in all imaging formats including Acrobat PDF.

OCIE allows users to quickly view old and newly published data with a few key strokes. OCIE is used to store accounting records, HR documents, financial records, health information (including patient account histories) and supply records. OCIE is a complete managed service solution with the hardware typically situated in the customer's data center or hosting site. OCIE contributes to a comprehensive disaster recovery solution because the OCIE Subscription Service includes the option of backing up all of an agency's archived documents off-site.

The pricing is simple. For less than a penny per page OCIE will capture, store, burst, collate, apply security and archive to WORM (write-once, read-many) media an entire audit trail. OCIE makes it possible to retrieve documents from anywhere, provided the user has the proper security permissions to access the system and is subscribed to the appropriate security group.

In addition, Donnell Systems provides consulting for Process Improvement and Business Process Re-engineering to help agencies automate back office business processes that are based on data contained in reports or documents captured and managed by OCIE.
